LIQUOR TAGS: These elegant pewter, Medici-style decanter tags from **Vagabond House** make great gifts, especially when paired with a bottle of your host's favorite spirit (\$22 each, vagabondhouse.com).

CANDLE: Scented candles are often a risk not worth taking. This magnolia-scented one from **Izola** strikes the right balance—clean and crisp but not overpowering (\$35, izola.com).
